Instrumental Music Tuition Application



Dear Parents/Carers

Extra-curricular instrumental music lessons are very enjoyable and beneficial to students and the school is very committed to providing this important service; the tuition encourages the student to take responsibility both for the instrument and their own learning. This letter is intended to clearly outline the costs and commitment involved but regrettably, the school is not in a position to subsidise the lessons although there may be some funding available through Pupil Premium for eligible students (please enquire with the Finance Office).

Please note there is a notice period of six weeks required to cease lessons once begun.

Charges: The charge per year from September 2025 will be:

- Group lesson: £342 (Monthly instalments £38 x 9 months from September 2025 to May 2026)
- Individual lesson: £783 (Monthly instalments £87 x 9 months from September 2025 to May 2026)

We require £60 **deposit** (£135 for individual lessons) by **School Gateway, bank transfer, cheque or cash** when first booking the lessons. This will be refunded at the end of the tuition, provided all payments are up to date. Further tuition payments will be requested through the School Gateway system by monthly instalments or can be cleared termly if preferred. Please contact the Finance Office if you need help with School Gateway. *It would be really helpful if you could download the School Gateway app so that the monthly reminder messages are free of charge to the school.*

Please do not hesitate to ask if you have any other queries or if your child needs extra support. We do have to commit to employing the music teacher for a certain period of time in advance, and therefore require **a notice of six weeks** in writing to cease lessons. Tuition fees will be reviewed annually.

The school will ensure that all students have a purposeful weekly lesson of half an hour, either individually or in a small group. If the student misses a lesson because the teacher is absent, extra lessons will be made up before the end of the term.

The students are expected to attend the lessons reliably, remember to bring their instrument and music and to practice. The timetable for lessons varies from week to week, in order to avoid missing part of the same lesson every week. The student needs to check the timetable posted regularly and make a note of the week's lesson time. A missed lesson cannot be made up but can be rearranged in advance in case of a trip or examination, for example. In exchange for providing the service, the school will expect all students to take part in at least one extra-curricular music activity when asked.

Hiring Instruments.

Instruments can be hired from Severn Arts via the school or from the school directly (subject to availability). Charges for instruments hired from Severn Arts or the school will be collected via School Gateway. In either case instrumental hire fees from September 2025 will be £40 per term.

Instrument Insurance

Free insurance cover is provided *for Severn Arts Instruments only*. The school will hold parents liable for damage and/or loss of school instruments but normal wear and tear will be repaired free of charge.

Would you please complete and return the slip below as soon as possible if you and your child would like to commit to the lessons; a copy will be returned to you for your records.
